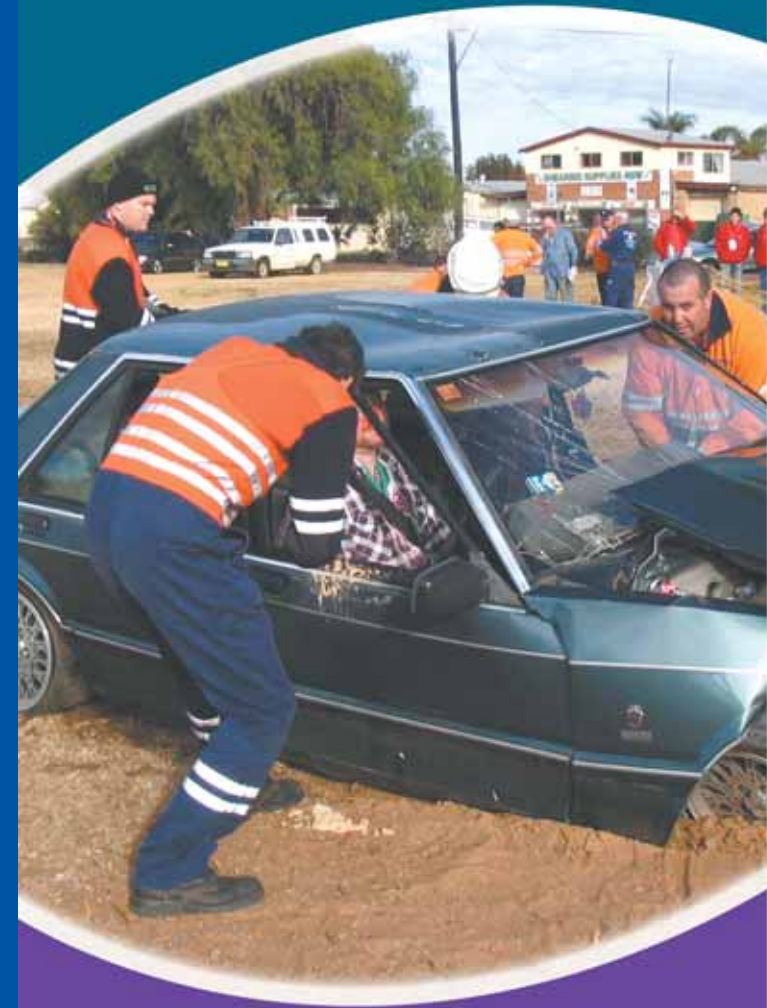

# Water Directorate Safety Competition 2008

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST


### When is this event?

 Wednesday 7th & Thursday 8th May 2008


### Where is this event being held?

 The Exhibition Centre at the Rosehill Gardens Racecourse, James Ruse Drive, Rosehill.


### What time will the competition be held?

 Teams will compete on the afternoon on the 7th and all day on the 8th May 2008.


### What will we have to do exactly?

 Select 4 employees from your organisation to participate as a team. Three of the team members will actively participate in the competition and the 4th team member will be the team manager.

### Who can be team members?

 Team members can come from experienced and qualified trades or workgroups. Apprentices are also strongly encouraged to participate. The team manager should be someone who has a wide range of skills and can guide the other team members with their skills and knowledge in the lead up to the competition and offer support on the day.

### What sorts of things will be in the competition?

 There will be up to three practical components taking approximately 15 minutes each plus a theoretical multiple choice question paper, totalling a competition activity time of about 1 hour.


The practical components could include tasks like changing a water meter, hazard identification and

risk assessment and dealing with emergency situations that may involve injured casualties. Emergency situations may include either overhead wires or underground services.


The usual operating equipment will be onsite, and the scenarios will be safe and realistic, with a strong focus on safety when judging the teams.

Teams are also encouraged to participate in the ESS08 Competition including First Aid, confined spaces, fire fighting and other energy industry specific events.


### Who is eligible to compete?

 Appropriately qualified staff from either member councils of the Water Directorate or staff from energy generation and supply organisations attending the ESS08.

### What will we win?

 There are trophies and prizes donated from suppliers and other associated industry supporters to win. PLUS there is the prestige of winning the Water Directorate Safety Competition 2008!
