

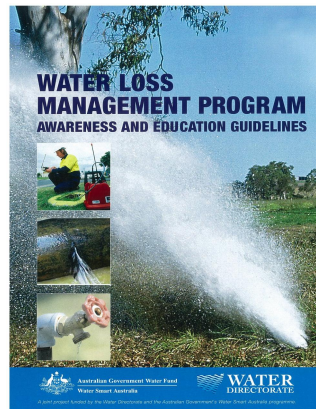
Awareness and Education Guidelines Workshop

PURPOSE

This Water Loss Management workshop will cover:

- an overview of water loss investigation including water balance and Infrastructure Leakage Index calculation for each attendees system
- the 4 management practices for managing real losses
- the principles and techniques of sectorisation (zoning), flow and pressure measurement, Active Leakage Control and pressure management
- flow/pressure measurement and datalogging, leak detection and pressure management equipment
- the Water Loss Management Program for regional NSW water utilities.



The Water Loss Management Program (WLMP) is a four year joint project by the Water Directorate and LGSA NSW which has \$7.4 million in funding from the Australian Government's Water Smart Australia programme. The Program and the Awareness and Education Guidelines are designed to encourage water loss management and leakage reduction across regional NSW.

Attendees will be able to use the WLMP Awareness and Education Guidelines and software (mailed to LWUs in Aug '06) to obtain a quick understanding of water loss in their local water system/s.
